

## November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018 CMTR Meeting Minutes

At approximately 11:04 am the board meeting started.

Board members Present were Shelli Ellis, Shannon Byerly, Chris Adams, Russ Johnson, Janie Anderson, Chad Bauer, and Dave Clements. Also present was Regional Training Coordinator, Jason Smith.

An introduction was conducted and a sign in sheet was passed around.

Jason Smith gave the financial report. As of the time of the meeting there was \$93,984.85 in the training line item, \$32,980.90 in the equipment line item, and \$14,334.20 in the scholarship line item.

### Old Business:

- Level I TA class coming up November 5-9 at Pueblo West Fire Station #3 cancelled.
- ASP Instructor course November 27-29, 2018 Pueblo Community College
- Reminder that on Scholarships you have 10 days after the class to get me required documents; certificate of completion or copy of roster, itemized hotel receipt (tax exempt), etc.
- Fountain PD ammo request for 10,000 rounds of 9mm for Transition Training (20850rds available)-approved for 5,000 rounds
- Training Opportunities email-**Jason asked if the training opportunities email that he has been sending out was helpful. It was agreed that the email was helpful. Jason will send out an email monthly and when he adds new classes.**

**Jason also discussed that POST is adding to their website training located throughout the entire state. He will send information via email when this is up and running.**

### New Business:

1. Becky and Jonathan from Rocky Mountain LE Credit Union
  - **Becky and Jonathan spoke about what Rocky Mountain LE Credit Union can offer Law Enforcement Officers. They would like to expand and meet with departments willing to have them come and present their information. If interested contact them and they will present at your roll call briefings.**
2. Level I TA class was cancelled for November 5-9. Rescheduled for January 14-18 (Pueblo PD).
3. Rescheduled Level II TA for February 4-15 (Fountain PD).

4. Pueblo County SO requesting 12,500 rounds of 9mm for shortage of Post Certified Deputies, and the need for armed personnel.
  - **A motion was made by Chris Adams to approve 6250 rounds. It was seconded by Chad Bauer and approved by all the board members except Dave Clements who abstained. (Approved for 6250 rds)**
5. Pueblo PD requesting 900 rounds 9mm and 300 rounds 40 cal to be used in a multi-jurisdictional training on 11/12/18 in El Paso County.
  - **A motion to approve was made by Dave Clements and seconded by Chris Adams. It was approved by all board members except Shelli Ellis who abstained. (Approved)**
6. Responsibilities for hosting agency; refreshments (may not exceed \$5 per day per sworn student) must be bought the morning of class; contact person available.
7. Regional Training Needs for this cycle.
  - **Classes mentioned were: train the trainer, driving instructor, supervision class, rifle course, hand gun instructor, Gracie Ground fighting, 3 day Armorer, LPO Class, CIT and Winning the Battle (possibly coming 3<sup>rd</sup> week of Jan, hosted by Pueblo County SO).**

#### **Misc Discussion**

- **Board members discussed keeping a supply of ammo on hand for CMTR hosted classes. It was decided to keep the following:**
  - **9mm-15,000 rounds**
  - **40- 15,000 rounds**
  - **45-12,500 rounds**
  - **.223-25,000 rounds**
  - **.308-2500 rounds.**
- **The board discussed getting rid of the .380 rounds and possibly trying to trade in or trade some of the 40 rounds as a lot of agencies are transitioning to 9mm.**
- **Woodland Park PD will be going to Monte Vista to pick up a driving simulator. Once up and running this will be open to all agencies that need to use it.**
- **Jason mentioned that he is speaking with Snowmass PD about obtaining a driving simulator from them.**

#### **Training Requests:**

The following training requests were brought forth to be voted upon by the board:

- Pueblo County SO requests \$975 to cover the class free of TASER Master Instructor Course.
- Pikes Peak Community College requests 2 scholarships of \$390 each (only class fee) to send to officers to Confronting the Toxic Officer.

All of the requests were unanimously approved by the board members present. Board Member Dave Clements did not participate in the vote regarding the Pueblo County

Request. Board Member Chad Bauer did not participate in the vote regarding the Pikes Peak Police Department Requests.
