

## August 2nd, 2018 CMTR Meeting Minutes

At approximately 11:00 am the board meeting started.

Board members Present were Shelli Ellis, Chris Adams, Russ Johnson, and Chad Bauer. Also present was Regional Training Coordinator, Jason Smith.

An introduction was conducted and a sign in sheet was passed around.

Jason Smith gave the financial report. As of the time of the meeting there was \$135,334.48 in the training line item, \$68,835 in the equipment line item, and \$29,132.36 in the scholarship line item.

- Jason mentioned that the training line item didn't include the Gracie School or Basic SWAT School that still needed to come out of the line item.
- Jason received a bid for a new F250 in the amount of \$34,900.

### Old Business:

- Payment for Year End accounting (\$475) to Nova Defense (spoke with Neal).
  - **This has been taken care of.**
- 2017-18 Grant ended June 30th. We spent \$291,422.60 out of \$291,707.04 (99.9%)
- Ammo Request from Pueblo PD for 3 Officers (300 rds pistol, 300 rds rifle) SWAT School. Board approved providing all students ammo.
- 2-day Instructor/Armorer Pepperball Training end of October or beginning of November. \$1,975 for 10 spots. Voted not to hold class.
  - **Pueblo PD is hosting a class on Oct 11, 12<sup>th</sup>.**
- 1-day Tactical Medical for First Responders August 20th and August 21st (Pueblo County SO Emergency Services Center).
- Novembers meeting on the 1st, changing it to the 8th? Pueblo County SO is hosting
- Looking for Agencies to host a Level II (December 3rd-14th) and Level III (March 25th-April 5th) Traffic Accident class (2 week courses)
  - **The Level II Class will be held at Fountain PD and the Level III class will be held at Pueblo PD.**

### New Business:

1. Ammo request from Woodland Park for Sgt Holzwarth to use while attending Firearms Conference in Utah was approved by email. 1800 rds 40 cal and 1100 rds 223.

  - a. **There was a general interest in this class from various agencies.**
